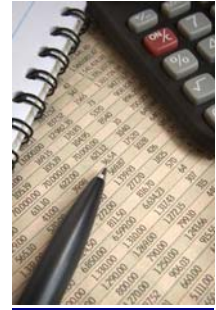


## Company Valuations
